Mountain update- Opening day is projected for beginning of December, weather permitting

Secretary Report – Meg

- Signups will open for first half. Sign up for a day within the first 3 weekend to do lift evac
  - If you care about your schedule sign up right away, if you don't care let other folks sign up first
  - Frank and Neil stated that it is very frustrating to have people sign up but not show up, contact
- In Case of Emergency list - a google docs version will be sent out to the patrol, please update yourself

Treasurer Report - PAUL

- We have money
- Lic plates \$10-12k- pays for dues, jackets etc.
- Budget will be ready at next meeting

Workmans' Comp - paid for patrollers who have signed up for shifts , plus candidates

- We contribute \$50 per active patroller to get workman's compensation coverage through the mountain. For those patrollers for whom patrol pays dues, patrol also pays this. This means that we have insurance coverage if we get injured while on duty as patrollers.
- However, in order to actually get coverage, if you get hurt patrolling, **report it that day to the team leader and the lead pro...** This includes candidates! You will need to fill out an accident report, just as you would for an injured patron.
- Must be wearing patroller or candidate jacket to be covered

Candidates and transfers - Paul & Cheri

- Confusion on website- \$400 paid by each candidate includes: book, dues, testing fees
  - Cheri discussed responsibilities: reading prior to class, class time spent on practical information
- Numbers and schedule- Meeting on Tuesdays 6:00-9:00ish pm, whenever a conflict with general patrol meeting meet on THURSDAYS, start date TBD, Cheri will announce shortly
- Frank brought up education advisor on monthly newsletter

- Blankets get bagged for high heat treatment in dryer next to rental shop; splints and tarp get sprayed with disinfectant. If you don't know where the dryer is, ask someone!
- Vaccine update -most patrollers seem to be vaccinated. If not, please do so!!! If you are vaccinated, as first responders we are all eligible for boosters. Again, please get a booster!!!
- Daily sign-up sheets will ask for vaccination and booster status. Out of courtesy to your fellow patrollers, please report your vaccination status.
- Covid protocols will be coordinated with the mountain and with the pros.
- Karl read statement re: COVID from Snowbowl newsletter.

#### OET/Lift Evacuation - Neil/Joe M

- Please sign up for OET/ toboggan refresher online. We all need to do this each year.
- Lift evac training plans- sign up for shift within first 3 weeks of mtn opening and hopefully Snow Park lift will be available for use.
  - Jack M to start taking over practical aspect of lift evac
  - Will continue to perform lift evac on Snow Park Lift- trainings to ensue when asked to run Snowpark lift.
- C+ Joe explained that OET will be running similarly, try to coordinate sat/sun trainings are similar- will need to OET course on nsp.org

- Frank suggested sharing list of patrollers needing ICS with Team Leads to help remind patroller to complete
