Treasurer- Paul

- Current balances
 - Checking \$38k
 - DA Davidson ~\$80k
- Paul doesn't have current budget
- Budget to e-board later this week
 - Consider purchasing a vacuum splint
 - Joe proposed we purchase splints with built-in straps- ask Art?
 - Neil discussed expenditures vs. income of patrol
- Check sent to Flight or Fight for first aid refresher
- License plates cut off- make sure that we have enough income from charity plates
- Have not yet paid dues for patrollers (\$108) or insurance (\$50)
- Discussed scholarships for candidates (P&P 1230)

 - Joe M wanted to add section on lap loading procedures- discussed as an e-board
 - Policies and Procedures Document
 - To present on Tuesday at General Patrol Meeting
 - Non-transporting policy change
 - People who have stopped transporting due to age/ injury, temporary or permanent
 - Junior patrollers- has OEC, OET, mtn won't let them transport
 - Other? Discussion ensued
 - Person has 2 years to become transporting



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- Language to be inclusive- already included at beginning of document that policies are flexible
- *Motion approved to send out P&P document to whole patrol
 - Discussion ensued re: when patrol meeting vote will occur; when will go into effect
 - Plan:
 - December release document to patrol
 - January feedback discussion
 - Maybe vote February, can move if much discussion

- Current Requirements
 - 5 classes re: differences between OEC and EMT
 - Pass OEC test on first try (\$60/test)
 - Rest of \$ is paying for book, parka, dues, \$25 for classroom
 - Discussion regarding challenge test in the fall and OEC final in the spring
